***Subject: Performance of Sea Marconi on the
Survey of PCB in the Power Sector in Lebanon***

To whom it may concern:


EDESSA in association with the UK Consultant SLR and the Italian Consultant WasteandChemicals was awarded from the Lebanon Ministry of Environment and Electricity of Lebanon the PCB survey in the transformers of Lebanon.

The survey included about 22,000 transformers. Oil samples were collected from older transformers (13,178). These were subject to screening using the SM-TCPs Potentiometric test Kit produced by Sea Marconi. Samples found to contain more than 50 ppm of PCB were sent to Sea Marconi for quantitative verification testing using Gas Chromatography.

As can be seen, Sea Marconi played a major role in this project based on their provision of the screening equipment and consumables and the confirmatory testing of PCB contaminated samples. Their professionalism and thorough cooperation throughout the project were key assets in helping us complete this challenging project.

We strongly recommend Sea Marconi for similar challenging projects and would like to take the opportunity of this letter to thank them for their involvement.
